iCRco donated a turnkey computed radiography system to be used in a remote clinic in rural Honduras. Inauguration of the clinic is set to take place February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010 with participation of community leaders, international volunteers and guests in Concepcion, Intibuca in Honduras. The CR system donated by iCRco was a critical part to the success of the clinic.
